<p>Feature #5622 added support to allow the target_version (<i>fixed_version</i> in the implementation) to be set in the contents on an incoming email; this is a useful addition.</p> <p>It would be really useful to also allow a default version to be set on the command line (for new tickets) when calling receive_pop3 or receive_imap. This would be really useful in cases where you want all new tickets to be added to a version such as 'Unassigned Backlog', 'For Review', etc...</p> <p>This is a very minor change to redmine/lib/tasks/email.rake to add fixed_version to the list of attributes that can be set for both :receive_pop3 and :receive_imap, and add a relevant description to the command line help. e.g. replace %w(project status tracker category priority).each { a options[:issue][a.to_sym] = ENV[a] if ENV[a] } with %w(project status tracker category priority fixed_version).each { a options[:issue][a.to_sym] = ENV[a] if ENV[a] }</p>
