Description <p>We often have multiple version open during our project process - so we can plan features for time periods ahead. Unfortunately some of the people involved in the project constantly assign issues to the wrong versions.</p> <p>Currently we lock all versions, until the PMs go in and unlock them so they can assign bugs to a version number - obviously this isn't very productive.</p> <p>I propose a Permission entry in the Permissions and Roles to "Assign Issue to Version", which when unchecked, disallows that role to assign a version to the issue, through updates or creating a new issue.</p>
