Sometimes a issue should be assigned to more than one person at the same time (for example change requests in our case are assigned to the project Change Control Board). It would be useful to have under the project settings a way to create groups of users and have its name available in the assign to dropdown list along with other users, so when a taks is assigned to the group an email notification is sent to all group members.

It is also difficult for bigger organizations with teams from different departments. It is probably related to #8891. Thanks.
