<p>filtering an issue list based on a category that is also in a subproject does not work.</p> <p>I was not sure if this is fixable as the category list is defined separately for subprojects.</p> <p>Steps to Reproduce:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Go to the Issues list for a project that has sub-projects2. Add a filter for "Category"3. set "Category" to a value that is defined in the parent and sub projects both. <p>Notice that results do not include subproject issues.</p> <p>This bug was found on our own Redmine server running 1.0.1. It was upgraded to 1.2.1 but the bug still exists.</p> <p>I then tried on the Redmine Demo site.
