I have already tried:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- upgrade of svn to version 1.6.x</li><li>- setting PATH in environment.rb</li><li>- change SVN_BIN in subversion_adapter.rb and adding stuff for certificates handling</li><li>- setting scm_subversion_command in configuration.yml</li></ul> <p>None of these works....</p>
