U can define a role giving it all rights, then create a group and give the group the role for all projects. I am not exactly sure which features are missing to "system admin" but for us managing projects is admin enough.

Maybe the plugin option "Attributes to be synced" can be enhanced to sync "admin" switch for redmine user object too. You then would need an Idap attribute for ur Idap user class with same name as redmine admin attribute.

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
