For instance, the "New Member" pane on the right hand side will show only show all users from letters A to M and then start showing all the different groups without inputting any search parameters.</p> <p>Workaround: If you input a search parameter for users beyond the letter "M" I am able to add those users into the system.</p> <p>Another issue is that I rely on users letting me know which user should be deactivated or removed from the system and it is difficult if they cannot see the whole list.</p> | | | |
