Similar issue in Armenia

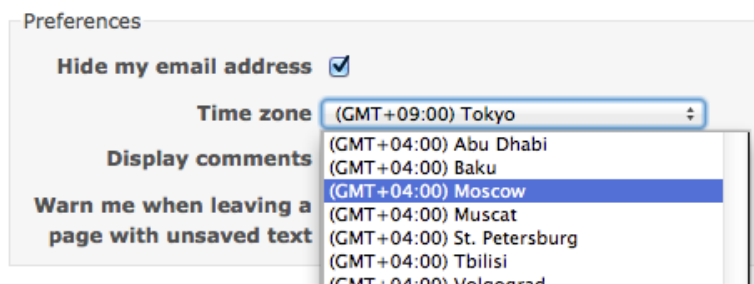
Summer time (AMST) has stopped being affected by the daylight saving time change beginning 2012, so during summer, the time zone stays the same (UTC +4).
